















ENTRY CONFIRMATION

Roadbook Issuing

The roadbooks will be handed out **in Hall 1 of the Freistadt exhibition hall, Am Stieranger 10, 4240 Freistadt.** during the following period:

Wednesday, 31.12.2025 from 18:00 to 19:00 Thursday, 01.01.2026 from 08:00 to 18:00 Friday, 02.01.2026 from 08:00 to 12:00

The make, color, and license plate number of the recce vehicle must be provided when the roadbook is issued. If the entry fee has not been received in the organizer's account, the roadbook cannot be issued!

The following material is provided when the roadbook is issued:

- Roadbooks
- Sticker for recce vehicle
- Tracking system

Deposit for GPS tracking system

A deposit of EUR 200,- in cash is required for the tracking system when the roadbook is issued.

Detailed information and instructions for the GPS system will be made available separately in Sportity before the roadbook distribution begins. A standard 1-inch Ram Mount ball is required to mount the devices in the rally car; this ball must be permanently attached to the vehicle. Teams can purchase and install this 1-inch ball themselves. Alternatively, 1-inch Ram Mount balls can be purchased on-site at the event.

















Recce

The timeframes for inspecting all special stages and the shakedown are listed in Appendix II of the regulations. Each special stage may be run **a maximum of three times**. Checks will be carried out using the GPS tracking system. The rules and penalties according to the current AMF Rally Sporting Regulations apply.

We plan to organize the Jännerrallye again in the coming years. Therefore, we ask you to avoid making a negative impression during your recce and to adhere to the speed limits – on special stages and liaison sections alike. Please bear in mind that not all residents and landowners are rally fans, and even a single incident could cause problems with future permits.

Service area

The service area is located at the exhibition grounds **around the Freistadt exhibition hall, Am Stieranger, 4240 Freistadt**, as well as on the paved part of the **ÖTB grounds** opposite the Hotel Freigold and at **Stifterplatz (bus station)**.

The service area can be occupied from Thursday, January 1st, 2025 at 12:00.

Should you wish to access your service area earlier, this is possible under the conditions listed in Article 12.5.7 of the regulations. **Unannounced early entry into the service park is not permitted** (except for arriving by regular car for roadbook distribution). **If participants or their service teams enter the service park early without prior notice and block the spaces of other participants, a penalty fee of EUR 1,000 will be charged!** If this penalty fee is not paid before the start of the event, the affected participants will not be allowed to start!

Space in the service park is unfortunately limited. We ask for your understanding that only service park requests submitted in a timely manner can be considered and that the assigned areas must be strictly adhered to so that every team can get its space.

The roads must be kept clear at all times!

Recce and other vehicles must be parked on the designated parking area in the meadow (marked in blue opposite the Hotel Freigold) on the rally days.




































Trailer parking

Due to limited space, trailers cannot be parked in the service area. Local teams are requested to leave their trailers at home. For teams traveling from further, there is a trailer parking area at the WIMBERGER premises, **WimbergerHof 1, 4291 Lasberg**.

The trailer parking area is 3km away from the service park.



If trailers are left parked in the parking areas at the exhibition grounds during the rally days, they will be removed at the owner's expense!

















Administrative scrutineering

Location: Rally HQ, Hall 2, Am Stieranger 10, 4240 Freistadt
Period: Thursday, January 1, 2026, between 12:30 and 19:00
Friday, January 2, 2026, between 8:00 and 14:00

Participants who do not book a time slot by December 31, 2025, will be assigned one by the organizing team. The booked time is binding. Attending at a different time may involve long waiting times.

Technical scrutineering is only possible after successful administrative scrutineering! Therefore, book your administrative scrutineering time before your technical acceptance time!

The following documents must be submitted and will be checked:

- Applicant license
- Driver's license (driver/passenger)
- Driving licence (driver)
- Vehicle registration certificate (vehicle registration document)
- Proof of insurance (liability insurance)
- Declaration of consent from the vehicle owner (if the driver is not the owner of the vehicle)
- Foreign entry permit (only applies to participants from abroad)
- Additions and completion of the entry form
- Service area deposit (€50 in cash upon administrative acceptance)

The following documents must be submitted and will be checked:

- Homologation certificate (original)
- Certificate of safety cell (cage)
- Safety tank certificate (if required in vehicle category)
- AMF car pass, AMF car pass historical, FIA HTP
- SOS/OK sign (DIN A3)

Licenses

Please note that you need a valid license for 2026!

It is not possible to compete at Jännerrallye 2026 with a 2025 license. Licenses can not be applied for on site at the administrative scrutineering, only online directly at your ASN. Please get in touch with your ASN as soon as possible, since some ASNs might not be available at 01.01.2026 and 02.01.2026.

If a valid license cannot be presented, the entry fee will NOT be refunded!

Approved tires

We would like to remind you of the **tire restrictions** during the competition: see Article 7 of the regulations. The tires used will be thoroughly inspected and recorded. After the service checkpoint at the refueling zone, there is a dedicated tire inspection area where each participant is scheduled for a 2-minute stop. The times for the liaison sections have been calculated accordingly. There will be at least one inspection in each section.

Shakedown

Location: Oberrauchenödt - Mitterbach

Time: Friday, January 2, 2026, from 13:00 to 16:15

Participation in the shakedown must be declared and paid for at the administrative scrutineering. The shakedown entry fee is €75 (included in the entry fee for Rally2 and RRC participants). Participation in the shakedown is **only possible after successful completion of the administrative and technical scrutineering**.

The shakedown session will have 30-second start intervals to allow for more rides. There is no limit to the number of rides per participant. We recommend taking advantage of the shakedown rides from the start at 13:00. Experience has shown that many participants try to ride at the end of the session, which can lead to longer waiting times and, in the worst-case scenario, participants having to be turned away at 16:15 due to time running out.

















Passenger during the shakedown

Under certain conditions, it is possible to bring along other co-drivers as guests during the shakedown. A liability waiver signed **personally by the co-driver is required**. This can be done either at Rally HQ or directly with the marshals at the prestart area during the shakedown. After signing, co-drivers will receive a non-transferable wristband.

Passenger wristbands will be checked at the pre-start shakedown!

Participants with a passenger without a wristband will not be allowed to start! There are ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS. Please do not attempt to start without a wristband. Such attempts delay the shakedown for all participants, as participants with passengers without wristbands will have to wait, turn around, or drive without a passenger!

A place for tyre changes and codriver changes will be reserved in the village of Schlag, opposite the commuter parking lot (<u>LINK</u>). As space is limited, we ask all teams not to park service vehicles there permanently and to keep their time on site to a minimum.

Driver briefing

Location: Freistadt Exhibition Hall, Am Stieranger 10, 4240 Freistadt

Time: Thursday, January 1, 2025 at 18:20 (English) and 18:40 (German)

Drivers and/or co-drivers of a team are **required** to attend the drivers' briefing. Failure to attend will result in a fine of €100 imposed by the rally organizers. Team members' attendance will be verified by signature on an attendance list.
